KDFM Audit Key - Security FAQs

The KDFM Audit Key is designed to collect device information from networked printers and copiers. The KDFM Audit Key is a read only tool. At no point does it write any information or make any changes to any device it connects to.

General

What protocols does the KDFM Audit Key use?

The KDFM Audit Key uses the Simple Network Management Protocol (SNMP). This is an industry standard protocol used to set and retrieve information from network enabled devices. If locally installed printer detection is enabled, then the KDFM Audit Key will use standard Windows API's to connect to a remote PC

Networked printers and copiers

What information does the KDFM Audit Key collect?

The IP address, MAC address, device description, consumable usage and meter reading information are collected. No other information is retrieved from the device.

How is this information stored?

The information is stored in a standard CSV file, which can be viewed by the customer.

Is any information sent anywhere?

No, retrieved information is stored on the KDFM Audit Key USB key

Is anything installed on the PC running the KDFM Audit Key?

No, the KDFM Audit Key software is completely self contained. No files are copied, or information are copied to the host PC.
